

Lanett honored by APPA for electric reliability

The City of Lanett Electric Department has received national recognition for achieving exceptional electric reliability in 2015. The recognition comes from the American Public Power Association (APPA), a trade group in Washington, D.C., that represents more than 2,000 not-for-profit, community-owned electric utilities such as the City of Lanett Electric Department.

“This honor recognizes utilities that are statistically thriving when it comes to reliability,” said Michael Hyland, Senior Vice President, Engineering Services, APPA.

APPA took the City of Lanett Electric Department’s reliability data compiled through its eReliability Tracker Service and compared it to the top quartile of system outage duration from national reliability data collected by the Energy Information Administration — an independent agency that collects, analyzes and disseminates national energy data.
