Regular Session -

The City Council of the City of Lanett, Alabama, met in a regular meeting on Monday, September 18, 2023, in the Council Chambers of the Lanett Municipal Complex at 6:00 P.M.

Council members present were Tony Malone, Tamalita Autry, Ronnie Tucker, Angelia Thomas, and Tifton Dobbs. Mayor Pro-tempore Thomas presided over the meeting.

Rev. Rodney Jones said the invocation and the pledge of allegiance.
