### **Regular Session -**

The City Council of the City of Lanett, Alabama, met in a regular meeting on Monday, August 4, 2025, in the Council Chambers of the Lanett Municipal Complex at 6:00 P.M.

Councilmembers present were Tony Malone, Tamalita Autry, Ronnie Tucker, Angelia Finley Thomas and Tifton Dobbs. Mayor Jamie Heard presided over the meeting.

Councilmember Autry said the invocation and led the pledge of allegiance.

Councilmember Thomas made a motion to approve the agenda. Councilmember Tucker seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Tucker made the motion to approve the minutes of July 21, 2025, Council Meeting. Dobbs seconded the motion. Motion unanimously carried.

Approval of Invoices was motioned by Councilmember Autry and seconded by Councilmember Thomas. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-25-01, a resolution to Impose a Lien on Crown Castle PT, Inc. was read by Councilmember Autry and put in motion by Councilmember Thomas and was seconded by Councilmember Tucker. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-25-02, a resolution to Impose a Lien on James Raymond Smith ETAL. was read by Councilmember Autry and put in motion by Councilmember Thomas and was seconded by Councilmember Tucker. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-25-03, a resolution to Impose a Lien on James Roberts was read by Councilmember Thomas and put in motion by Councilmember Dobbs and was seconded by Councilmember Autry. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-25-06, a resolution to Impose a Lien on James Roberts was read by Councilmember Thomas and put in motion by Councilmember Thomas and was seconded by Councilmember Autry. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-25-07, a resolution to Impose a Lien on Dwight Leroy Culberson was read by Councilmember Thomas and put in motion by Councilmember Thomas and was seconded by Councilmember Tucker. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-25-08, a resolution to Impose a Lien on Manuel De Oliviera was read by Councilmember Autry and put in motion by Councilmember Malone and was seconded by Councilmember Thomas. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-25-09, a resolution to Accept Lowest Bid from Old South Roofing for Emergency Roof Replacement at James Hardy Gym and Lanett Senior Center was read by Councilmember Thomas and put in motion by Councilmember Malone and was seconded by Councilmember Thomas. Motion unanimously carried. Tucker asked if the city would be paying funds for this or if the insurance would cover it. It was noted that AMIC Insurance would cover it due to this being hail damage.

Resolution 08-25-10, a resolution to Accept Contract for Professional Services between City of Lanett and GMC, LLC for Regional Airport Taxilane Pavement Maintenance was read by Councilmember Autry and put in motion by Councilmember Thomas and was seconded by Councilmember Dobbs. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-25-11, a resolution to Accept USDOT Federal Aviation Grant Offer for Airport Improvement Program was read by Councilmember Autry and put in motion by Councilmember Thomas and was seconded by Councilmember Tucker. Motion unanimously carried. Caleb Williams of GMC was on hand to answer a question asked by Malone. Williams stated that this was for the access road and this was just a follow up from the FAA on grant that was previously applied for.

Mayor Heard appointed Herchell Allen to the Housing Authority Board. This would be to complete the term of his wife Wanda who passed.

Council Member Malone had no committee report. He asked Johnny Wood how the process was going to apply for Historical status of Nadine's Doll House in Oakwood Cemetery. Wood stated that the application was still in process.

Council Member Autry had no committee report. She reminded everyone that Lanett school would be starting on Wednesday.

Council Member Tucker had no committee report. He thanked the Street Department for placing a No Dumping sign on Phillips Rd.

Council member Thomas had no committee report. She also thanked the Street department for cutting trees back in district 4. She also thanked the Code Enforcement Officer for working on dilapidated houses.

Council Member Dobbs had no committee report.

Mayor Heard thanked the Restoration Committee for their monthly cleanup. He also reminded everyone about the National Night Out on Tuesday at 5:30 to be held at the Rec Gym due to impending weather.

Mayor Heard asked for a motion to adjourn. Malone made the motion and Thomas seconded. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
